Achievements

First Sri Lankan Public Library's Koha Based OPAC on the Web

Mr. M.N.Ravikumar, Senior Assistant Librarian, Eastern University Sri Lanka has successfully installed and customized Koha open source LMS at Pethalai Public Library, which is coming under the authority of Koralaipattu Pradeshiya Sabha, Batticaloa and launched the OPAC of the library on 11th October 2016. This is the first Koha based full featured OPAC of a Public Library live on web in Sri Lankan history. In this event Mr. M.N. Ravikumar was honored by the Asst. Commissioner of Local Government for his valuable service rendered to the library.





Participation of Cultural Partnership Initiative (CPI) Programme at Korea

International Information and Networking Centre for Intangible Cultural Heritage in the Asia-Pacific Region (ICHCAP) of the UNESCO is operating Cultural Partnership Initiative (CPI) Programme, since 2012. In 2016, ICHCAP had selected four highly qualified young professionals in the intangible cultural heritage field throughout the Asia-Pacific region, out of thirty-four applications. Miss. A. V. M. K. Ankumbura, Assistant Librarian, University of the Visual and Performing Arts had been one of the four. Other three professionals came from Mongolia, Tonga, and Malaysia.



Program was held from August to December 2016. In early August 2016, the participants began their five-month sojourn in Korea. As part of the program, Miss. A. V. M. K. Ankumbura involved in various projects, including individual research, participation in ICHCAP's projects and meetings, and networking with other ICH experts. The various projects were designed to help the participants better understand how Korean policies and systems for ICH safeguarding operate, which will then enable the participants to compare the Korean systems with their own country's system. ICHCAP expects this year's program to play a significant role in building a strategic project model in partnership with the participants' agencies to foster an ICH network in the Asia-Pacific region.
